XVII. Recent County Commission Items Submitted at Wednesday, February 19, 2025 Meeting

- a. First Reading Item Proposed Changes to CZABs 54-page item by Commissioner Gonzalez FAILED by 7–5 vote
 - Proposed renaming to "Resident Zoning Boards"
 - Appointed (not elected) members
 - Limited powers/duties
 - BCC comments included: "These boards need to be 'restructured'"
- b. Second Reading item by Commissioner Cabrera For developments of 20 units or less, doubles "payment in lieu of" requirement for workforce/affordable units
- c. Solid Waste Memo Mayor includes report putting decision back to BCC

County staff has not responded or made progress on these items:

- i. Soil Re-Use Guidance Revised memo expected in ~3 months (originally promised by end of 2024)
- ii. FEMA Maps DERM responded to FEMA's reply on Aug 8th
 - 1. New FIRM maps likely by mid-summer 2025
 - 2. Municipalities must adopt maps within 6 months of release







- iii. Wetlands Mitigation Banking DERM could not facilitate requested meeting
- iv. SB 1532 now law Allows purchase of stormwater credits & public-private partnerships
- b. Wellfield Modeling Pulled from BCC agenda; COI maps under internal review
- c. Manatee Protection Plan No updates from staff
 - i. BASF submitted comments nearly 10 years ago
 - ii. Received only outdated FWC documents in response
